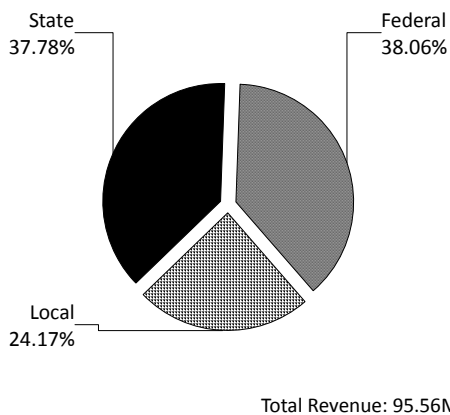

Revenue Sources



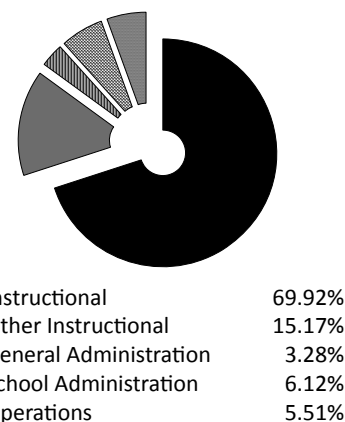
