WHEREAS, teaching is an increasingly complex profession, and our teachers fill many roles as motivators, researchers, mentors, scholars and exemplars; and


WHEREAS, our teachers spend countless hours preparing lessons, evaluating progress, counseling and coaching students and performing community service; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County School District Board of Education recognizes the critical importance of teaching and supports its teachers in educating the students of this community; and




