

SCIENCE FAIR INFORMATION

Turn in dates for **regular 5th grade students only**. Third and fourth grade students turn in all materials on March 5th. Fast Forward students turn in only the final project.

January 29th RESEARCH PLAN – Typed must include: Question being addressed, Hypothesis, Problem, Engineering Goal, Description of the procedures and how you will collect data, and Bibliography. The bibliography must contain 5 different sources.

FEBRUARY 26th ABSTRACT – Typed must include: Name, School, Title of Project, and Purpose of the experiment, Procedures, Data and Conclusions.
